The Embassy of Israel in Hanoi presents its compliments to the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has the honor to reply the Note No. 539/CH-LS-PL regarding to the Certificate of Vaccination of Israeli as below:

Information about the Israeli Certificate of Vaccination:

*Please see below for reference an Israeli Certificate of Vaccination

- The Israeli Certificate of Vaccination is issued by the Israeli Ministry of Health.
- The certificate is bilingual, written in Hebrew and English.
- Information fields displayed on the Certificate
 - Full name
 - Passport Number and National ID Number
 - Date of Birth
 - Inoculated Since (one week after receiving the second dose)
 - Expiration Date
 - Epidemiological information: date of vaccination, 1st and 2nd dose, vaccine type, institution which administered the vaccine was given.
 - QR Code
- The QR Code enables the authentication of the certificate. Currently the authentication app is available in all major app stores.

Immigration and Quarantine Policies in Israel

- Currently all those who enter Israel, be they Israeli citizens or foreigners, vaccinated or non-vaccinated, are required to take a PCR test with a negative test result up to 72h before entering Israel, and take another a PCR test upon arrival to Ben Gurion Airport in



Tel Aviv. Until receiving the test result (which can take up to 24h) one is required to quarantine.

- Entrants with a Vaccination Certificate issued by a foreign country can take a serology test/antibody test upon entrance to Israel. If the test result is positive (implying the person has enough antibodies), they will be granted a status of a patient who recovered in Israel including domestic green pass and often exemption from quarantine.
- Those who enter Israel from countries that have been categorized as high-risk countries, even if they have been vaccinated, are required to enter a 14-day quarantine. The quarantine can be shortened to 7 days, if one takes an additional PCR test on the 7th day and receives a negative result.

Mutual recognition of foreign-issued of Certificates of Vaccinations

Currently Bahrain has signed a mutual recognition agreement with Israel. Additionally, Israel is in the process of negotiating a mutual recognition of vaccination certificates with the EU, and is expected in the next weeks to adjust the current format to the European one.
