The Embassy of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to Viet Nam, presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam and has the honour to refer to the Ministry's Verbal Note no. 539/CH-LS-PL dated 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021, regarding the Certificate of Vaccination against COVID-19 issued by Luxembourg health authorities.

- i. As a Member State of the European Union, Luxembourg has endorsed the EU Digital COVID Certificate, used among all 27 EU Member States as well as in Liechtenstein, Norway and Iceland. The Certificate issued by the Ministry of Health of Luxembourg bears on its cover page the letters "LU" inside the flag of the European Union, under the title EU Digital COVID Certificate written in English and in French language. For ease of reference, a sample of Luxembourg's Digital COVID Certificate is enclosed.

The Certificate includes further information regarding the country of issue; the disease covered (i.e. Covid-19); vaccine type (i.e. SARS-CoV-2 antigen vaccine); the vaccine medicinal product (i.e. brand name of the vaccine inoculated); manufacturer, number of vaccines in a series of vaccinations (i.e. 1/2 or 2/2, or 1/1 for Johnson); the date of vaccination (last injection); the certification issuer (in this case: the Ministry of Health).

On the back and right above the personal data of the vaccinated person (surname, first name, date of birth and a unique certificate number), the Certificate bears a QR code, which contains all of the above information and certifies the authenticity of the information provided, while it also ensures a very high degree of protection against counterfeit attempts.

The Certificate can be electronically authenticated with the app "CovidCheck.lu" which is available from the usual application platforms in IOS/Apple or Android format and which can be downloading by Vietnamese Authorities.

- ii. Citizens of the European Union and of the countries associated with the Schengen area, as well as citizens of San Marino, Andorra, Monaco and the Vatican/Saint See, are free to enter the territory of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, without quarantine, regardless of the purpose of the stay and not only to return to their homes.

Third-country nationals may not enter the territory of the Grand Duchy until 30 September 2021. Exempt of this rule are persons and nationals from the list of third-countries, special administrative regions and entities and territorial authorities, available under this link: <https://covid19.public.lu/en/travellers/visiting-luxembourg.html>

For any person, aged 12 years or older, authorised to enter Luxembourg (regardless of nationality), it is compulsory to present, before boarding a flight to Luxembourg:

- either a vaccination certificate attesting to a complete vaccination pattern (see FAQ) carried out with a vaccine that has been authorised for use by the European Medicines Agency, i.e. the vaccines of the companies AstraZeneca, BioNTech/Pfizer, Johnson&Johnson and Moderna, issued by a public or medical authority of a Member State of the European Union or of a Member State of the Schengen Area;
- or a recovery certificate issued by a practitioner or national authority of an EU Member State or Schengen Area Member State for persons who have had a recent SARS-CoV-2 infection within 6 months prior to travel and who have completed the applicable isolation period in the respective country with resolution of all symptoms of infection;
- or the negative result (on paper or electronically) of a nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT) for the detection of SARS-CoV-2 viral RNA (PCR, TMA or LAMP methods) carried out less than 72 hours before the flight or of a SARS-CoV-2 rapid antigen test carried out less than 48 hours before the flight, by a medical analysis laboratory or any other entity authorised for this purpose. The negative result of the test must be presented, if necessary accompanied by a translation, in one of the administrative languages of Luxembourg or in English, Italian, Spanish or Portuguese

This applies to all departures to Luxembourg, including those from Member States of the European Union or the Schengen area.

- iii. Luxembourg does not negotiate bilateral recognition agreements on its own with other countries and relies solely on agreements negotiated by the European Union on behalf of all 27 Member States.

The Embassy of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam the assurances of its highest consideration.
